## Interested in Purchasing Tax Credits to fund Catholic School Scholarships?

### Who can contribute?

- An individual
- Corporation
- S-Corp

### Fit in one of those categories?

### Here is how it works:

Regardless of being an individual or corporation you can receive 100% credit for purchased tax credits to be used for 50% of your annual State income tax obligation. Can't spend them all? It's ok you have up to 4 years after the year of purchase to use them.

Example: If you owe \$5,000 in Missouri State Income Tax you can use up to \$2500 of purchased Missouri tax credits. If you buy \$10,000 worth of tax credits your set for 50% of your tax obligation for 4 years.

### I'm ready to purchase. What do I do?

1. Go to [Brightfuturesfund.org](http://Brightfuturesfund.org) and click on the "reserve your tax credits" link (available late June)
2. You'll be directed to fill out the short online form reserving your credits. Note: be sure to select **Bright Futures Fund** as the organization. (You'll see a running tally of how many credits we have left.)
3. Print out the email confirmation you receive and send it and your donation\* to:

4. Bright Futures will acknowledge receipt of your donation. We will then confirm with the state and you'll receive your official tax credit certificate in the mail.

\*Donations must be made by check, ACH transfer, or debit card. Credit cards can not be used. If you wish to contribute electronically go to [brightfuturesfund.org](http://brightfuturesfund.org) and select tax credits under the "Donate here" button. Then email us your tax credit confirmation to [moscholars@diocesekcsj.org](mailto:moscholars@diocesekcsj.org).
