The state of Missouri allows you to direct up to half of your business & individual state income taxes to education. 100% Tax Credit at no extra cost to you - tax dollars you must pay anyway. Transform lives with your taxes!

Maximize the impact your business tax dollars have on Catholic education in Missouri at no extra cost to you. Businesses and individuals can redirect up to 50% of state income tax liability to the Bright Futures Fund, providing vital scholarships to qualifying students in the diocese.

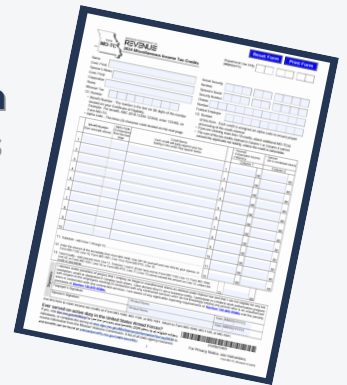


HERE'S HOW:

- 1. Estimate: Use your 2024 tax liability to estimate your 2025 state income tax liability. Some businesses chose two quarterly payments as estimate. Consult your professional tax advisor.
2. Reserve: Visit BrightFuturesFund.org and click 'Reserve Tax Credits' (linking to the MO State Treasurer's website). Select 'Bright Futures Fund' as your Educational Assistance Organization (EAO) and reserve up to 50% of your estimated liability.
3. Confirm & Contribute: You'll receive email confirmation from the state. Mail your check for the reserved amount to Bright Futures Fund, P.O. Box 419037, Kansas City, MO 64141, by December 31, 2025.
4. Claim: When filing your 2025 taxes in 2026, use the state's email confirmation along with an MO-TC form to claim your 100% tax credit.

Your tax dollars, already owed, can directly transform lives through Catholic education. Join us in expanding scholarship opportunities for students across our diocese.

Next school year, with your help, Bright Futures Fund will provide over \$10 million in scholarships in 31 schools in the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph, entirely funded through tax credits.



- Reserved tax credits are equal to 100% of an eligible contribution and can be used for up to 50% of the donor's annual tax liability.

Tax credits may be carried forward for four additional tax years. Tax credits are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be sold.
